#### **CFBC Purpose**

To study the horticultural development of trees and shrubs as related to oriental bonsai, their origin and their place in our world, and to share ideas, thoughts and knowledge with those interested in learning the art of bonsai, to the mutual benefit of all.

## 2014 Epcot® International Flower & Garden Festival

For the last six years, Disney has graciously offered CFBC to be included in their annual festivity. Although bonsai artists from around the state of Florida submit trees to BSF for display at the Japanese pavilion, our club and its members are directly connected to this event in a different way. Inside The Wonders of Life building Disney provides space for local clubs and organizations to display and promote nature-oriented programs involving bird watching, orchid growing, or composting. Our club uses the space we are provided to display trees and promote the art of Bonsai.

On Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays during the Flower and Garden, two volunteer members from CFBC gain back stage access at EPCOT to safely deliver their trees and materials. They arrive at approximately 9:30 to set up their designated area and proudly display the trees which have been styled for years. CFBC has educational materials to view and handouts for those interested. Guests arrive at 10:00. This is when the Question and Answer fun begins. Quite often the first question that is asked is "How old is it?" Luckily, there are intelligent question asked as well involving soil, pots, styling, wiring, joining clubs, or purchasing of trees. This continues until 3:00 when trees are gently packed to be returned our personal gardens and materials stored for the next day's volunteer.

Because CFBC has been involved in this joint venture for several years and retains excellent rapport with Disney, our location within The Wonders of Life building has been elevated to the most prominent location. As guests enter and exit the building, bonsai trees are the first and last things they see. There have even been returning guests after a few years who say they are glad to see our club still exhibiting.

This year, Disney is using a theme format for the Flower & Garden Show. This is the only reason CFBC will not be involved every weekend during the show. Members have already scheduled themselves for days during the festival and are eagerly awaiting their chance to promote the Art of Bonsai. 





