

**Meeting:** Friday, August 11, 2017. Annual "Adam Lavigne and Mike Rogers" carving workshop

Attendance: 21 members signed the attendance sheet. Head count was 25

**Treasurer's report:** The club's account and records are currently in transition from the out-going treasurer, David Dean, to the new treasurer, Mark Ceskavich. They are meeting at the bank to transfer the account and update the signature cards.

**Discussion:** The club was informed that we will no longer be able to use our current meeting place. Adam has been in touch with Cullen Mariacher from American Bonsai Tool and Supply, and he has generously offered his office/warehouse for our use.
